Wynell Sturrock Hollomon, 92, of Port Neches, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, April 27, 2017. Her father was a share cropper and her mother was a homemaker. She went to school in Colmesneil, TX. She was a 6th grade teacher, a reading specialist, a supervisor before becoming the first female school principal for the PNGISD. After Leon passed away in 1989 she married Jack Davis in 2002. Jack attended school with her in Colmesneil, then he passed away in 2005. She was interested in reading, travel, canning and family. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Port Neches and Delta Kappa Gamma.
